
As a resident of southeastern North Carolina, I have watched the news coverage of the proposed CSX container hub in Johnston County with great interest.

Given that the property you had initially identified in Johnston County has encountered in some obstacles in terms of local support, I encourage you to consider potential locations near the existing CSX lines in Robeson County.

If a suitable property could be acquired in Robeson County, this would provide close proximity to I-95, easy access to the Port of Wilmington via U.S. 74/76 and your existing rail lines, and the Piedmont Triad via I-73/74.
